






Making a strip of paper to the size you need is easy when you know what to do. These simple instructions show you how!

Instructions

- Place your paper or card, wrong side up on a hard flat surface. 
- On the piece of paper, line up the ruler along a short edge of the paper, measure the width the strip needs to be, and make a pencil mark on the paper in that spot. Repeat on the other end of the paper. 
- Line up the two marks with the ruler and hold the ruler firmly against the paper. 
- Draw a line from one pencil mark to the other. 
- Cut the paper along the line. 
- If you need the strip to be a specific (exact) length, measure along the long edges of the strip and make pencil marks as in step 2, and rule a line from one pencil mark to the other as in step 4, and cut along the line.
