

We have a super quick and cheery flower magnet to make that will bring a little smile to her face. You can glue glitter in the middle, instead of having a disc in the centre, and without a magnet on the back, it can be used to decorate a present or a greeting card.

Instructions

- Print out the templates on the following pages on lightweight card, or glue them onto card, and cut around the flower of your choice.
- 2. Cut out an "I love you" circle or write a message on a milk bottle lid disc with a pen or permanent marker.

If you don't want to have a message, skip step 3 and spread glue in the middle of the lid and sprinkle with glitter.

Glue the circle or disc, facing up, inside the bottle lid, pressing it in firmly.

metal surface.

Glue - glue stick, PVA glue or double sided tape


Pen or fine tip permanent marker to write a message or glitter

Flat magnet




